A report, entitled [Monitor 2000](#) has recently been published by the Ayrshire Joint Structure Plan and Transportation Committee, the first of its kind in Scotland.

If the Structure Plan is to be successful it must be able to respond to changing circumstances. This requires them to be monitored on a regular basis to reflect changes in policy, development pressure and priorities.

As part of the approved Structure Plan, the Ayrshire Councils agreed to a monitoring statement prepared on a two yearly cycle this has now been published.

The document presents a range of economic, social and environmental data. Its purpose is to indicate how the plan's policies are achieving their declared aims – the performance of the plan – whilst also documenting the challenge faced by public and private sector agencies.
